Dear Parents and Guardians,

BUILDING OPENING CEREMONY – THURSDAY 27TH

In conjunction with LifeHouse conference, on Thursday the 27th of February LifeHouse is holding our Building Opening Ceremony.

While this event is not officially a part of LifeHouse Conference, we have put it on the same weekend as conference to help us celebrate the season of 'Momentum' ahead of us. The event will include self-guided tours of the new facility from 6PM with the ribbon cutting at 7:15PM. There will be finger food & refreshments followed by a dedication service with a message from Ps Wayne Alcorn - our ACC National President.

We are running a kids program and have an entertainer booked in for some fun. **You will need to register yourself and your children in order for us to plan accordingly via the church website.**

PRE-SCHOOL AGED

As always, we are excited to be running full pre-school programs during every session of conference! Kids will enjoy worship, crafts, and an exciting curriculum.

For both Friday & Saturday (Friday night session especially), we ask that you pack a pillow, blanket & comfort toy for all pre-school aged kids.

Friday 28th February (Night Session) 7:30pm – 9:00pm:

Worship, crafts, low-energy games, video, Bible stories and quiet time.

Saturday 29th February (All-Day) 10:00am – 4:00pm:

Worship, multiple activity stations set up, games, dance, nap time, story time & 1 hour with a balloon twister & face painter.

PRIMARY AGED

This year we have a fun filled and action-packed program planned for the whole weekend. Primary school children will be living it up in our brand new KidsWorld Mini Auditorium!

Friday 28th February (Night Session) 7:30pm – 9:00pm:

For opening night we have an action packed program planned including praise and worship & preaching in our brand new auditorium plus a jumping castle & theme based crafts.

Saturday 29th February (All-Day) 10:00am – 4:00pm:

Saturday will start with an engaging and inspiring service. Worship and our BIG Curriculum will be running in conjunction with a theme based craft.

After lunchtime and back by popular demand, we will be going on an excursion to **GoClimb Coburg**, an indoor playcenter & obstacle course. Please send your kids with their own backpack with **lunch, afternoon tea and a drink bottle**. A 'what to bring' list is below, but the main things for the Saturday are a water bottle, jacket, and nut-free snacks & lunch. We will be leaving LifeHouse Church at 12:00pm and returning at 2:30pm. Additional information and a bus consent form will be emailed to you leading up to the event and will be available at check in on the day.

CHECK IN

If your child has asthma or anaphylaxis you are required to bring along their asthma puffer or EpiPen, and also their action plan. **Without this they will not be able to attend the program.**
